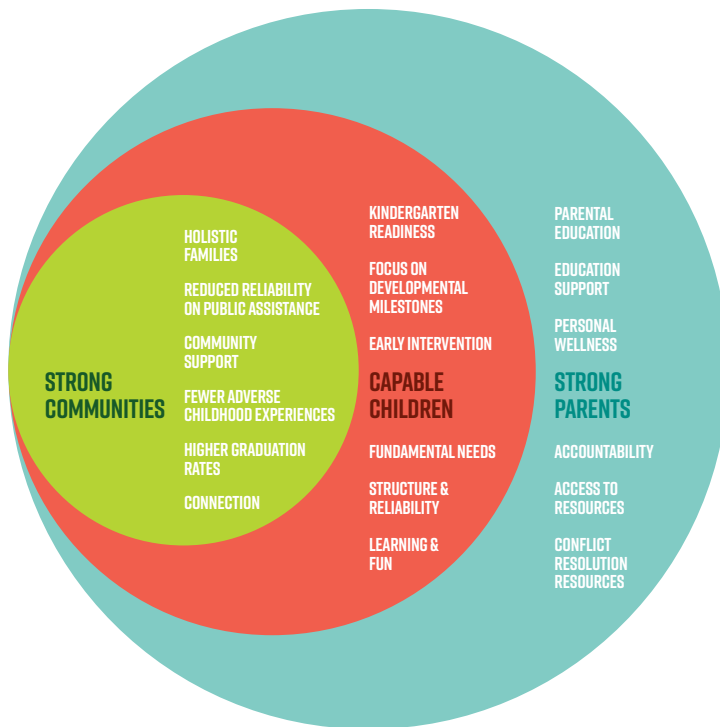


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IMPACT.



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Together we do this through:

- Establishing pregnant clients in care early, reducing a risk factor to infant mortality.
- Eliminating barriers to care in the areas of housing, healthcare, transportation, economic, and childcare through the Abundant Life Program.
- Equipping moms through their first and second trimester with educational classes on health during pregnancy, relationships, safe sleep, breast feeding, car seat safety and more.
- Equipping moms during the third trimester in creating a birth plan and preparing for a baby.
- Equipping dads in connecting with baby, supporting the mother of their child during pregnancy and childbirth, healthy discipline and co-parenting.
- Parenting classes that teach healthy relationships, co-parenting, bonding with babies and healthy discipline.
- Educating children 0-5 years old in our 5 Star Early Childhood Education setting- ensuring children are Kindergarten ready.
- Engaging parents in the development of their children by involving them in the completion of screenings, annual conferences and teaching them about the education of their child.
- Supporting the completion of their education with access to tutors, a study space, accountability, scholarship opportunities and the necessary items needed to navigate through graduation.
- Providing weekly parent education classes that teach life skills, financial literacy, child development, healthy relationships, workforce development and their overall health and well-being.
- Mentoring clients through daily interactions, goal setting and crisis intervention.
- Encouraging dads to become dedicated, accountable, determined and strong through consistent and positive contact with their child.
- Providing legal services for paternity, custody, child support and visitation.
- Helping families bridge the gap between adversity and resiliency by utilizing a trauma informed approach.



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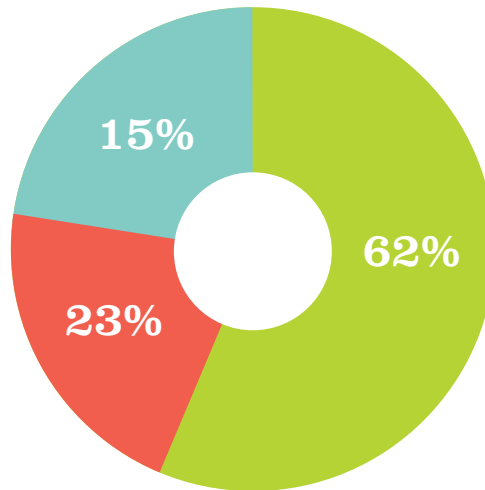

- The playground where children can express their creativity in a safe place while gaining independence and building relationships with their classmates.

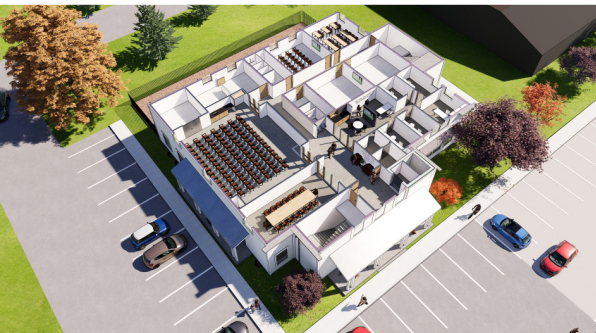
